- Vehicles in the circle drive need to move forward as far as possible toward the flagpole.

Finally, I want to remind you that because this is the time of year when illnesses are going around, we want to continue to be proactive in keeping everyone safe and healthy. As a reminder, if your child does not feel well or is sick with nausea, vomiting, diarrhea, has a sore throat or fever--or a combination thereof--please keep your child at home.
